Take Hwy 24 west from Lawrence approximately 15 miles, or east from Topeka approximately 7 miles.  
Turn north on Hwy 237, go 3 miles. Follow park signs to horse camp.

**Date:** Check-In: Saturday, July 24  
Ride: Sunday, July 25

**Time:** Pre-ride check-in starts at 3:00 pm on July 24. Please inform the commissioner if you expect to arrive after 7:00 pm on Sat.

**Fee:** \$36/Adult, \$26/Junior  
Park Fees: Vehicle fee: \$4.20, Camping fee: \$8.50

**Deadline:** Friday July 9. Day-of entries accepted with a \$5 late fee. T-shirts will not be guaranteed after the deadline.

Plenty of water is usually available along trail sections of the park.
