Directions from I-70: Take Exit 295 US 77 turn North, 4 miles. Turn Left onto KS 57 (about 3.5 Miles) Cross the dam and turn Left at Milford State Park Sign. follow MOTDRA signs into ride camp.

All Milford Campground Rules Apply. All vehicles must display a daily or annual State Park Permit. Trails are easy with very little rock. A great barefoot trail!

ALL MOTDRA RULES APPLY: Animals must be at least 4 years of age for the 25 mile ride and 3 years of age for the 15 mile ride.

A negative Coggins Test within one year is required for this ride.

Horses should be capable of a 5-6 miles an hour pace. Any kind of tack is permitted.

No liniments or drugs of any kind.

Insect repellents, electrolytes, food supplements, etc... are O.K.

Horses needing treatment will be stabilized by ride vet and any and all fees will be the total responsibility of the rider/owner. Junior Riders must have a signed parent/guardian release and a pre-determined riding adult sponsor. Jr. Riders are required to wear a riding helmet.

Entry Fee: \$40.00--25 mile ride.

\$30.00--15 mile ride.

Add \$10.00 for non- MOTDRA members

One time Camping Fee is \$10.00 to be paid with entry fee:

DO NOT pay at the park office.

Camping at special use area with water and porta potty available.

(Showers on camp grounds)

Electrical hook-ups for volunteers only no extra charge.

No refunds once the horse has passed the pre-ride vet check.
