General Rules:

Entries open to all breeds of horses, ponies and mules.

Animals must be at least 3 yrs for 15 miles and 4 yrs for 25 miles.

Coggins test within 1 yr. Health cert. not required but please don't bring a sick horse.

These trails are rocky; so shoes are recommended.

Any tack is permitted but NO bandages, wraps or protective boots. NO liniment or drugs but insect repellents, electrolytes, food supplements are ok.

Horses should be able to do a 6 mph pace.

Rider should think of their horse's welfare before any awards.

***All Jr. riders under age of 18 Must wear a helmet.**

***All Jr. riders MUST have a predetermined riding sponsor.**

Will try to have farrier on hand.

Pre ride vet check on Aug 16th will start around 3pm. We'll break around 6pm for dinner and ride meeting. So bring your favorite dish and join in for the fun.

Directions:

From Overbrook: Turn south off US 56 on Main street through town. Go 7 miles on Bk. Top to 205th/110 Mile Park sign (this is on a curve). West 3 miles to 110 Mile Park sign then left and follow road into the park. Horse camp is on S West corner.

From US 75: East on 189th Street 2½ miles. Right on Cocoa Rd./110 Mile sign & follow signs to 110 Park and on into camp.

From Ottawa: West on K68-268. Right/North across Pomona Dam to Stubbs Rd./Stop sign. Left through Michigan Valley to 205th Street. West to Park sign and in to camp.
