So bring your favorite covered dish and join enjoy the potluck before the ride meeting starting at ~6

GENERAL RULES

Negative Coggins test within one year required.

Entries open to all horses, ponies, and mules. Animals must be at least 3 years of age to do 15 miles, at least 4 years of age to do the 25 miles. Horses should be capable of 6mph pace. No liniments, drugs, or wraps will be allowed. Hoof Boots maybe worn but removed for the final vet check. Any kind of tack, electrolytes, feed supplements & insect repellent are okay. Jr. Riders under age 18 need a signed parent/guardian release as well as a predetermined riding adult sponsor. All riders are required to wear a riding helmet.
